**Ciprofloxacin and prolonged QTc interval and Torsade de Pointes  
as agreed following the PhVWP in February 2007**

**Section 4.4 - Special Warnings and Special Precautions for Use**

**Cardiac disorders:**

Since ciprofloxacin is associated with very rare cases of QT prolongation (see section 4.8), caution should be exercised when treating patients at risk for torsade de pointes arrhythmia.

**Section 4.8 - Undesirable effects**

**Cardiac disorders / Frequency unknown**

Ventricular arrhythmia, QT prolongation, torsade de pointes. These events were observed predominantly among patients with further risk factors for QT prolongation (see section 4.4).
